

## Instructions for San Diego District Scholarships

Our funds are managed through The San Diego Foundation. The CA-AFCS San Diego District scholarships are part of the *Common Application*.

### Required:

- One letter of recommendation must come from an instructor or professional on official letterhead indicating the student's interest in pursuing a career in one or more of the fields listed under eligibility below.
- Fill out the basic information. You have an opportunity to apply for many different scholarships. CAFCS-SD has four (4) separate ones:
  - CAFCS-SD/Henry R. Hague, J.D. Scholarship Fund
  - CAFCS-SD/Ellen Ferguson Snyder Scholarship Fund
  - CAFCS-SD/San Diego Scholarship Fund
  - CAFCS-SD/Peggy R. Hollenbeck Scholarship Fund

- The number and amounts vary from year to year.
- Deadline: Applications are available in early December and the deadline for returning them is the end of January or early February. Check on The San Diego Foundation scholarship website for exact dates.

### Eligibility

- Graduating high school seniors, current college students, or graduate students majoring in the following programs: Food Service; Dietetics; Nutrition; Hospitality; Human, Child and Family Development; Apparel, Fashion and Textile Services; Housing and Interiors; Consumer Economics; Management and Resources; or Family and Consumer Sciences Education.
- Those planning to or currently attending an accredited two-year college, four-year university, or licensed trade/vocational school in the United States.
- Undergraduate recipients must be enrolled full-time (12 units) per semester or (9 units) per quarter; graduate students may be enrolled full-time or part-time with awards allocated appropriately based on enrollment units.
- Preference for the recipients will be San Diego residents; however, CA resident students will also be considered.
- Must have a minimum 2.50 GPA on a 4.0 scale.
- Past recipients may re-apply and will compete with all other applicants.
