PROPOSALS are requested for poster or creative presentations by individuals or student groups for this conference on any topic related to family & consumer sciences content.

Projects will be displayed Saturday of the conference (March 26) at 8:00 am.

EXAMPLES:

Summary of a research project, field experience, community engagement activity, garment design, interior space design, menu or diet plan, children's learning tool. These may be displayed on a table (provided), on a dress form or mannequin (provided), or on a poster (provided by you).

PROPOSAL SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- At least one author must be registered for the conference.
- You may submit up to two proposals.
- Contact person will be notified of acceptance via email by March 9 with more conference details.

Submit proposals via email using the following process (one email per submission). **In the body of the email state the following:**

1. Presenter name(s) and college or university attending
2. Title of presentation
3. Email and phone of contact person
4. Presentation format (please request table, dress form or mannequin and size)

Prepare a 1/2-page abstract/summary of your proposed presentation explaining the nature and importance of your project. For apparel design proposals, prepare an abstract and include photos of garment front and back.

- **Save** your file in Word format with filename consisting of your last name, Undergrad, and a number if submitting more than one abstract (e.g., Smith1Undergrad.doc *or* Smith2Undergrad.doc).
- **Submit** your proposal **as an attachment to your email** to nrabolt@sfsu.edu.
