## Deadline for District Scholarships Applications ranges from March 10 to April 1, 2022

CA-AFCS districts are pleased to be able to offer scholarships to qualified students.

**Bay District** \$1,500 available to members of the Bay District only. General eligibility requirements must be one of the following:

- a graduate or undergraduate student majoring in Family & Consumer Sciences or specialization
- a student obtaining a Family & Consumer Sciences credential at an accredited college/university

**Marguerite Fenner Scholarships** \$1,500 (2 or more scholarships generally available). Available to women enrolled in Northern California college/university at the time of scholarship award.

- You may submit applications from March 1-April 1, 2022.

**North Central District** two \$1000.00 scholarships will be given and if desired a \$200.00 stipend fund towards attending the CA-AFCS professional conference in San Diego, March 25 & 26, 2022 will be awarded to the two qualified applicants.

- Any FCS full-time upper division students at a 4-year institution in the LA area, in Family and Consumer Sciences.
- Graduate Fellowship in Family & Consumer Sciences – \$1000

**San Diego District** A number of scholarships between \$1200-\$3000 are available this year to eligible applicants; funds may be used for tuition, fees, books, room & board, and other educational expenses. Due date is March 10, 2022 at 2pm.
